Cookies Policy

This Cookies Policy ("Policy") explains how Bravenly Global, LLC ("we," "us," or "our") uses cookies and similar tracking technologies when you visit our website at <https://bravenlyglobal.com> ("Site"). This Policy is intended to comply with applicable U.S. state privacy laws.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device by websites you visit. They are widely used to make websites work, enhance user experience, and provide information to website owners.

Cookies set by us are called "first-party cookies." Cookies set by parties other than us are called "third-party cookies." Third-party cookies enable third-party features or functionality to be provided on or through the Site (e.g., advertising, interactive content, and analytics). The parties that set these third-party cookies can recognize your computer both when it visits the Site and also when it visits certain other websites.

2. Purpose of Cookies

The purpose of a Cookie is to identify the user as a unique user of the Site. For example, we use Cookies to customize your experience on the Site to your interests, to ensure that you do not see the same informational messages repeatedly, and to store your username so you do not have to re-enter it each time you visit the Site.

We use first- and third-party cookies for several reasons. Some cookies are required for technical reasons in order for the Site to operate, and we refer to these as "essential" or "strictly necessary" cookies. Other cookies also enable us to track and target the interests of our users to enhance the experience on the Site. Third parties serve cookies through the Site for advertising, analytics, and other purposes. This is described in more detail below.

3. Types of Cookies We Use

The specific types of first- and third-party cookies served through our Site and the purposes they perform are described below (please note that the specific cookies served may vary depending on the specific website you visit):

- a. **Strictly Necessary Cookies** – Essential for the operation of our Site, such as enabling page navigation and access to secure areas.
